

Self-Employment Income Support Scheme (SEISS)

YOU'VE CLAIMED – WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

HMRC

- HMRC will check your claim before you receive your grant
- Your grant will be paid in one payment into your bank account within 6 working days



FROM 25TH MAY



- If you haven't been paid 6 working days after making your claim, then you should contact HMRC
- If you think you're eligible to claim, but haven't been invited to by HMRC – use “eligibility checker” and make a claim

KEEP A COPY OF ALL RECORDS INCLUDING:

- ✓ The amount claimed
- ✓ The claim period
- ✓ The claim reference
- ✓ Evidence that your business has been adversely affected by COVID-19



WHAT DO YOU NEED?



- Business accounts showing a reduction in turnover
- Confirmation of any coronavirus-related business loans received
- Dates your business had to close due to lockdown restriction
- Dates you or your staff were unable to work due to coronavirus symptoms, shielding, school closures

YOU'LL NEED TO REPORT THE GRANT

- ✓ on your Self Assessment tax return for the tax year 2020-2021.
It will be liable to income tax and national insurance
- ✓ as self-employed income for any claims to Universal Credit
- ✓ as self-employed income and that you're working 16 hours a week for any credit claims
